(year of publication). "Title under inverted commas", in: name and surname of the editor with the addition
of (ed.), Name of the book or proceedings in Italics. Publisher, Place of publishing, page(s). Example:

John Smith. (2017). „International Customs“, in: Tom Snow (ed.), *International Law*, London, 45-90

ARTICLES IN JOURNALS OR MAGAZINES: Name and surname of the author. (year of publication).
"Title under inverted commas". Name of the journal or magazine in Italics, Volume number (part number),
page(s). Example:

John Smit (2017): "Customary International Law", *Journal of International Law* vol. 25, 73-100
or

John Smit (2017): "Customary International Law", *Journal of International Law* 1/2017, 73-100

LEGAL AND OTHER DOCUMENTS – Listed at the end, including the necessary elements such as
the date when they were signed or adopted, and where they can be found (UN Collection of Treaties,
Official Gazette No. etc.).
